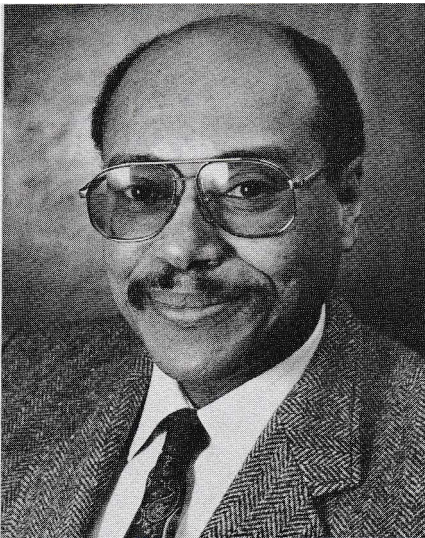


Act 101 Salutes Charter Director Alonzo Cavin

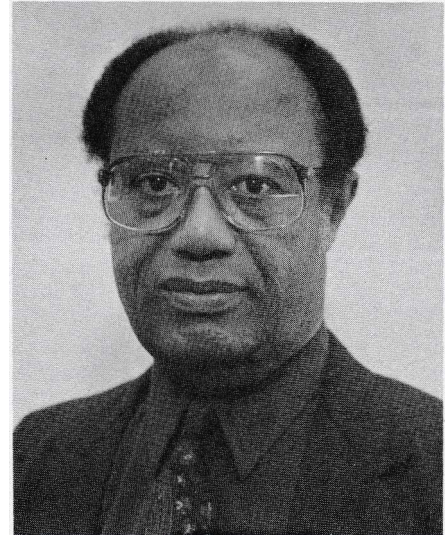


Alonzo C. Cavin, Ed.D., received his B.S. in English Education from Cheyney State College, his M.S. in English Education from West Chester State College and his Ed.D. in Curriculum Theory from Temple University. He is an Associate Professor of Education at Widener University. Dr. Cavin also serves as a lecturer at the Institute of International Education at Lincoln University and faculty for the National Council of Educational Opportunity Associations. Previously, he developed curriculum for the Delaware Curative Workshop, taught middle school in Wilmington, Delaware, and served in the U.S. Navy as a General Line Officer. He is the author of numerous publications and has received many awards for professional and community service. Dr. Cavin is a leader and/or member of many organizations including the PA Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development, PA Association of Educational Opportunity Program Personnel, the Governor's Council for Exceptional Children, PA Association of Teacher Educators, American Association of Colleges of Teacher Education, Eyre Drive YMCA and the Chester Wallingford Red Cross.

Dr. Cavin has been the Director of Project Prepare since its inception in 1969, and with the advent of Act 101 in 1971, became an Act 101 Charter Director. He has chaired the Eastern Region Directors' Association, been a member of the Executive Committee for at least 15 years, served on task forces to write directors' manuals and design the final report format, and co-chaired the Education Action Committee. In 1990, Dr. Cavin was awarded the Outstanding Service Award by the Act 101 Directors' Association.

Karl H. Lewis has three degrees in Civil Engineering, a B.S. from Howard University, and an M.S. and Ph.D. from Purdue University. He is a full time faculty member in the School of Engineering at the University of Pittsburgh, with teaching, research and administrative responsibilities. Professor Lewis has served as Chairman of the Geotechnical Engineering Group and Chairman/member of several senate and university-wide committees at Pitt. In addition, he is an engineering consultant to two established companies in the Pittsburgh area, and has traveled and worked with them on projects in the United States, as well as in Pakistan, Belize, Venezuela and the Middle East. He is a member of national honor societies in Engineering, Civil Engineering, Science, Mathematics and Scientific Research, member of several professional engineering societies, and recipient of numerous awards. Dr. Lewis has been a Director of the American Society of Civil Engineers, the Maritime Transportation Research Board (National Science Foundation), the Pittsburgh Folk Festival, Inc., and the Pittsburgh Regional Engineering Program.



Dr. Lewis founded the Pitt Engineering IMPACT Program in 1969, and with the advent of Act 101 in 1971, became an Act 101 Charter Director. He has served the Act 101 Directors' Association as Chairperson, Treasurer, and Chairperson/member of several of its committees. In addition, he has chaired and served on task forces to design proposal and evaluation formats, and to reform Act 101 Guidelines. He is currently Chair-Elect.

As leaders, they are dependable and give continuously of their time and talents.
